DECLARATION OF PREGNANCY

I, the undersigned, declare that I am pregnant. I understand the radiation dose to the embryo/fetus during my entire pregnancy will not be allowed to exceed 0.5 rem (5 millisieverts) TEDE (unless that dose has already been exceeded between the time of conception and submission of this declaration of pregnancy). I also understand that meeting the dose limit for the embryo/fetus may require a change in job or job responsibilities during my pregnancy.

If I find out that I am not pregnant, or if my pregnancy is terminated, I will promptly inform my supervisor and Radiation Safety in writing that my pregnancy has ended.

I understand I may speak with a staff member or Radiation Safety about my radiation exposure.

Overview

The RS-13 is a single-page form used by a woman to declare a pregnancy. You must suspect, or know, you are pregnant to use this form. You cannot use this form to take advantage of the lower dose limits if you are not pregnant. Use of the form in this manner may result in disciplinary action.

You are not required to declare your pregnancy. If you choose not to declare, the lower embryo/fetus dose rates WILL NOT apply and no special action can be taken to lower your occupational dose (e.g. temporary change in job duties), even if you are noticeably pregnant. If you do choose to declare and later wish to rescind your declaration, you are free to do so; however, you must rescind your declaration in writing to RS.

Most of the information on this form is not available to the public. The information is protected by the Privacy Act of 1974, Public Law 93-579, 5 U.S.C. 552a, and the USNRC regulations in 10CFR part 9, available at RS (10CFR20.2106(d)).
